## **2010 Junior Queen Contestant Requirements**

Thank you for considering the Creston Classic Rodeo Junior Queen Contest. This is a fun and worthwhile event that supports our small community.

Please take a moment to look over the requirements before you apply. There are a few commitments beyond the rodeo event itself. The Junior Queen will participate in various events to promote the Creston Classic Rodeo throughout the year.

The CCR is scheduled for the weekend of September 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> 2010.

\*Must be a resident or attend school in SLO or South Monterey County.

\*Age 11 – 15 as of the first day of the rodeo.

\*Must qualify with equestrian ability:

-Qualifications include: basic riding knowledge & ability. This includes, but not limited to, walk, trot, lope, turn, stop, a clover pattern, poles, figure eight and the ability to carry a flag while riding.

\*Judging will be based on horsemanship, presentation of personal interview, essay, appearance/personality and ticket sales.

\*Must have a \$250 sponsor, business or private. Your sponsor will be recognized in the rodeo program and on the back of your sash.

\*Must enter in at least one Creston Classic Rodeo event.

\*Contestants will host the Creston Classic Rodeo Queen/Family Dance held September 4, 2010 at the Creston Classic Rodeo Grounds.

\*Must attend all 3 days of the Creston Classic Rodeo.

Requirements of the winning Junior Queen are mandatory and are as follows:

\*Participate in the Pioneer Day Parade in Paso Robles on October 9 and Colony Days Parade in Atascadero held on October 16.

\*Volunteer at 2 Creston community events.

The 2010 Creston Classic Rodeo Junior Queen will receive a sash, crown and \$100.00 prize money (money to be awarded after all requirements are met.)

**The deadline for entries is June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2010**

**Applicants will be asked to meet with members of the Creston Classic Rodeo at the Rodeo Arena on June 5<sup>th</sup> @ 9AM with her horse to demonstrate horsemanship.
